The Preliminary Competition Schedule of the ISSF World Championship is attached to this General Information.

The Final Competition Schedule (including Training Schedule) will be distributed after the Final Entry Deadline (30 days before the Official Arrival Day).

The latest Schedule updates will be provided at the Technical Meeting.

3. Rules and Regulations

The ISSF World Championship will be conducted according to the ISSF Rule Book 2023 V02 (Rules and Regulations Chapter 11 for ISSF Target Sprint Competition), Edition 2023 – Effective 1 January 2023". Detailed information is available on the ISSF website www.issf-sports.org.

ISSF Juries (Jury of Appeal, Competition Jury, RTS Jury and Equipment Control Jury) will be designated by the ISSF to supervise the ISSF World Championship. Qualified Range Officers / Referees holding applicable ISSF licenses will conduct the competitions.

Rifle / Pistol Equipment

Equipment Control will be conducted according to ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Pre-competition testing is not mandatory; however, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to

Equipment Control for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random post-competition testing according to ISSF Target Sprint Rule 6 and will be disqualified if their equipment or clothing is not legal according to ISSF Rules.

Air or CO₂ Cylinders

It is the athlete's responsibility to ensure that any air or CO₂ cylinder is still within its validity date. This may be checked by Equipment Control.

4. Participation

ISSF Member Federations may enter a maximum of six (6) athletes per individual event.

Team Events (Men and Women)

ISSF Member Federations may enter a maximum of two (2) teams per team event, consisting of three (3) same-gender athletes which are entered for the ISSF World Championship in an individual Senior or Junior event.

Mixed Team Event

ISSF Member Federations may enter a **maximum of three (3)** teams, consisting of one (1) man and one (1) woman which are entered for the ISSF World Championship in an individual Senior or Junior event.

The maximum number of starts per event is the number of athlete / team entries that can be accepted for each ISSF World Championship event.

If the maximum number of starts is reached during the Final Entry process, a "waiting list" for that event(s) will be established. If cancellations are subsequently received, entries from the waiting list will be entered on a first come, first served basis. ISSF Headquarters and the Organizing Committee will cooperate to determine if additional entries from the waiting list can be accommodated.

ISSF ID Number

All athletes must sign an "Athlete's Declaration" and have an official ISSF ID number issued before participation in the ISSF World Championship.

Athletes without ISSF ID number will not be allowed to participate. ISSF ID numbers can be obtained from the ISSF Headquarters by using the official application form.

Juniors

Juniors are athletes who will be under the age of 21 on 31st December 2024.

Athlete biographies will be distributed, and photos will be taken.

5. Entry Process

Please complete the attached Registration Forms (Annex 1 – 9) and return them by the established deadlines.

Preliminary and Final Entries for Athletes and Officials must be returned to the ISSF Headquarters. All other Registration Forms must be returned to the Organizing Committee (see also: “Summary of Deadlines”).

Preliminary Entries

ISSF Member Federations entering the ISSF World Championship must submit the Preliminary Entries not later **than 18 APR 2024**.

Please use the ISSF Online Registration Service <http://entry.issf-sports.info>, or exceptionally complete the Preliminary Entry Form (Annex 1) and return it by email or fax to the ISSF Headquarters.

There is no Online Registration for the team events.

Final Entries

ISSF Member Federations must forward their Final Entries directly to the ISSF HQ. The Final Entry Deadline (30 days before the Official Arrival day) **is 18 JUN 2024**.

Please use the ISSF Online Registration Service <http://entry.issf-sports.info>, or exceptionally complete the Final Entry Forms (Annex 3) and return them by email or fax to the ISSF Headquarters.

Final Entries for the team events (special registration form will be available) must be submitted to the Organizing Committee upon arrival during the Registration Process. There is no Online Registration for the team events.

Late Entries

If the maximum number of athlete entries has not been reached, late entries will only be accepted until the Late Entry Deadline (3 days before the Official Arrival day) which **is 14 JULY 2024**.

Any additional entries received after the Late Entry Deadline, from **15 JULY 2024** onwards, may not participate.

Entry Confirmation upon arrival

All Team Leaders of ISSF Member Federation Delegations must report to the OC Entries Official and confirm their Final Entries including entries for the team events. The confirmation must be completed before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training.

Cancellation

Any ISSF Member Federation that reduces the number of athletes listed in their Final Entries after the Final Entry Deadline (**18 JUN 24**) must pay applicable entry fees and hotel room cancellation costs according to the number of athletes and entries on the Final Entry Forms originally received. If the applicable fees and costs are not paid, no member of that federation may participate.

NO ENTRY FEE PAYMENT TO THE ISSF

Please transfer all payments not later than **15th of June 2024**.

All amounts must be paid in EUR and must include any transfer fees or similar fees that the bank may charge. Take care that all necessary data is transferred, so that the Organizing Committee can assign payments to the correct federation. Please give a copy of the bank transfer voucher to your Team Leader to bring with him / her to the Entry Confirmation.

The Entry Confirmation / Registration will take place at **the Competition Office Dingolfing GER**. All payments made at the **Competition Office Dingolfing** must be paid in cash in EUR (**EUR only**) to the Organizing Committee upon arrival (no credit cards accepted). **Please be aware that there is no ATM or bank on the Competition Office Dingolfing or close nearby!**

Time frame: **19 JULY 2024, 8:00h till 12:00h at latest!**

Accreditation Process

All persons involved in the ISSF World Championship (Athletes, Team Officials, ISSF Officials, OC Officials, Media Persons) must have accreditations that clearly identify the accreditation holder (with photograph, family name and first name, nation and function) in order to use the local transportation and to enter controlled areas on the venue.

Accreditations (for persons registered before the Late Entry Deadline and with photograph in the ISSF database) will be prepared by the ISSF Headquarters and Organizing Committee. All other accreditations will be prepared by the Accreditation Office of the ISSF World Championship. Accreditations and BIB Numbers will be distributed by the Organizing Committee after payment of the entry fees.

7. Immigration and Customs Requirements

Visa

All National Federations that need official invitations from the German Shooting Sport Federation are requested to order these before **15 June 2024** (Annex 7). Please provide us the Visa Support Form **typed on PC** and as a **word document!**

Unless the Organizing Committee receives a special request, the invitation will be send by e-mail. If an express service is requested, the cost of this service will be charged to the federation and must be paid to the Organizing Committee upon arrival.

The German Shooting Sport Federation can provide invitations **for the period of the ISSF World Championship Target Sprint Dingolfing ONLY!!!**

Gun License

All nations **without the European Firearms Passport (EFP)** and all nations who do **not belong to the European Union** have to be in possession of the approved gun importation form (Annex 8), certified by the German authorities. Please make sure that you carry along a copy of your certified gun form. Additionally it is recommended to all delegations to carry a list of all firearms and ammunition with themselves, to be presented to customs or border police upon request together with the invitation.

ATTENTION:

Please do only use the attached Arms and Ammunition Declaration (Annex 8.1 and 8.2) for bringing in firearms and ammunition into the Federal Republic of Germany!

Please fill in the form completely and do not change the form or use your own form! Incomplete Forms cannot be arranged and will be sent back!

The forms have to be sent back to the Organizing Committee by email till **15 June 2024** latest.

You do **not** have to declare **air guns** and the proper ammunition at all, if they conform to the international standard. Please note: To import air guns without an auxiliary permission, they must have the international embossing / stamping “F”.



Owners of an **European Firearms Passport (EFP)** may even import their firearms **without** an auxiliary permission to Germany.

IMPORTANT:

No guns and ammunition transport is allowed by railway or other public transport facilities!

All delegations must inform the *organizing committee* about their arrival and departure details in time.

10. Competition Related Procedures at the Shooting Center / Venue

Technical Meeting

The Technical Meeting will take place **on 19 JULY 2024 at the Venue / Shooting Center Dingolfing**.

Each participating ISSF Member Federation should have at least one representative present at the Technical Meeting to receive updated information regarding Final Competition and Training Schedules, draw procedures and other important issues related to the ISSF World Championship.

The time of the meeting will be confirmed after the Final Entry Deadline.

Storage of Firearms and Ammunition

It is not allowed to take any arms and ammunition out of the Venue and especially not to the hotel. This German law also must be followed strictly by nations that are in the **possession of an European Firearms Passport!!** The armory will be checked every evening to be sure all guns are returned. **The armory will be open from 18 JULY to 22 JULY 2024 ONLY!**

For arrival please note:

Upon your arrival in Germany (**Dingolfing**), all guns and ammunition must be transported to the Shooting Center **Dingolfing in the most direct way**. All federations entering Germany must store their arms and ammunition on the Shooting Center **Dingolfing ONLY**.

There is no possibility to have “Pre Competition Training” on the **Marienplatz Dingolfing** or other facilities.

For departure:

All arms and ammunition must be removed from the armory to the airport **in the most direct way**. Even owners of an European Firearms Passport must pick up their arms and ammunition at the armory at time of departure, not earlier. Please keep in mind, that in Germany even owners of an European Firearms Passport are not allowed to leave their arms and ammunition unattended.

Ammunition

Additional ammunition can be purchased at the Shooting Center Dingolfing.

Doping Control Tests

The Organizing Committee will conduct Doping Controls Tests according to the ISSF Anti-Doping Rules and the ISSF Test Distribution Plan under the supervision of the ISSF Technical Delegate.

Victory Ceremony

The Victory Ceremonies will take place at the “Marienplatz” immediately after the end of each Final (see also: Final Competition Schedule).

During the ceremonies the athletes are required to present themselves in their official national uniform or national tracksuits (tops and bottoms).

Flags and Anthems

The Organizing Committee does not need any flags or anthems from the delegations.

12. Weather Information

You may expect minimum temperatures of 25°C in the days and not less than 15°C in the nights. Nevertheless, temperatures in Dingolfing are very unpredictable, so it could be very hot or rainy and cold. So please be sure to check the weather forecast before your departure to Dingolfing.

13. Media Relations

All Media representatives must register for the ISSF World Championship by using the Media Accreditation Form (Annex 9). A Media office, with all the necessary internet and other office facilities will be available at the **City Center Dingolfing**. Sufficient electrical outlets for personal laptops will be provided also.
